Participating in the South East Regional Skills Canada Competition

Skills Canada Competitions feature the talents of Alberta's trade and technology students. Regional Skills Canada Competitions connect students to local post-secondary and industry leaders. By taking their skills out of the traditional classroom setting, students gain an appreciation for where their skills can take them, and are encouraged to reach for their personal best.

*In order to compete at the Provincial Skills Canada Competition in Auto Service, Cabinet Making, Carpentry, Culinary Arts and Welding students must qualify at their Regional Skills Canada Competition.

In 2011, nine Regional Skills Canada Competitions will take place across Alberta. The top performers at the South East Regional Skills Canada Competition will earn a spot at the 19th Provincial Skills Canada Competition, on May 11-12, 2011 at the Edmonton Expo Centre. Teachers may register their students directly into the Provincial Skills Canada Competition for events that are not hosted at the regional level.

Gold medalists at the Provincial Skills Canada Competition will become part of Team Alberta and will compete at the Skills Canada National Competition in Quebec City, June 1-4, 2011.

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Registering for the South East Regional Skills Canada Competition

The South East Regional Skills Canada Competition and the Provincial Skills Canada Competition registration opens on **Monday, February 28 at 7:30 am**. Registration is administered on a first come, first serve basis through SkillsAlberta.com.

Please follow these steps to register your competitors:

- If you do not already have a Login Name and Password, register to become a **Skills School** at **SkillsAlberta.com**. Once registered you will be emailed a Login Name and password for your school.
- Go to SkillsAlberta.com and select **Login** from the top right side of the homepage
- Enter the Login Name and password provided to you when you became a Skills School. Select **Login!**
- Once logged in, select **Register Competitors**.
- Select the **Program** you wish to enter *i.e.* South East Regional Skills Canada Competition.
- Select the **Event** you would like to reserve a spot for *i.e.* Carpentry, Culinary Arts, etc. Click **Register Students**.
- **Indicate the number of spots** you would like to reserve for that event. Select **OK**.
 - **Auto Service - 3 teams allowed per school**
 - **Cabinet Making - 2 competitors allowed per school**
 - **Carpentry - 1 competitor allowed per school**
 - **Culinary Arts - 1 competitor allowed per school**
 - **Hairstyling - 3 competitors allowed per school in each level**
 - **TV/Video Production - 1 team allowed per school**
 - **Welding - 5 competitors allowed per school**
- If a competitor spot is available in the selected event, it will indicate that your registration was successful.
- If spots are not available in the selected event or if you would like to request a spot for an additional competitor, select the **Waiting List Request** link on the left side of the page and **Add Request**. Additional Competitor Requests will be granted by March 16. Registration for competitor spots closes on March 11.

All competitor personal contact information, including contact information pertaining to additional spots that have been granted, must be submitted online 2 weeks before the competition. Release forms must also be faxed in 2 weeks before the competition.

- Once logged in click **Competitor Information**. Select the Program - South East Regional Skills Canada Competition. Select the pencil icon to add the competitor's information.
